Dear Mr. Thompson,


Your daughter, Mrs. Miller, after her Lecture on the Geology of Kerry, told us of your interest in Irish hill-names.

INTRODUCTORY NOTES

In the I.M.C. Journal of March 1951, an appeal was made to members to collect information for a "2,000 ft. list," and since that time the need for such a list has grown, with the introduction of a qualification for membership of the Club (the ascent of ten 2,000 ft. mountains in Ireland). Then the appeal met with no response we had the idea of making a provisional table, based on map study, supplemented by our own, and Mr. C. W. Wall's personal knowledge of the Irish hills, which would indicate to mountaineers these areas in which there was the greatest need for research.

The most important tasks in improving this list are the search for local names, where none are given on the map, the determination of height of unmeasured tops, and the decision as to whether alleged tops are "separate mountains", "subsidiary tops", or merely "shoulders". These tasks demand much time and intimate local knowledge, and we hope that the errors of this list will act as a spur to others to carry on the work, and make possible the production, in a year or two of a full and accurate list.

Many will disagree with us in our classification of separate mountains and tops, and in our rejection of certain recognized mountains as shoulders. In general a top in this list is separated from its neighbour by a ridge. The difference between separate mountains and subsidiary tops is ill-defined, and the decision is a personal one which cannot be insisted upon.

The information in the list is derived mainly from the half-inch to one mile O.S. map of Ireland, which is the largest scale contoured map covering the whole country. It is a scale unfortunately too small to show many mountain names and heights. The six-inch, one-inch and quarter-inch sheets have also been used, especially the contoured one-inch sheets, Killarney, Dublin, Wicklow, and the Mourne Mountains. The disadvantage of these last is that above one thousand feet they have only 250 ft. contours. All information not taken from the $\frac{1}{2}$ inch map has its source noted at the foot of the page. We acknowledge the great debt we owe to "Munro's Tables of Scotland's Mountains, attaining an altitude of 3,000 ft. or over", which we have followed in the general arrangement of the list. We include an equivalent of Munro's second Table in a List of the Separate Mountains arranged in order of altitude; we have insufficient information of exact heights to include tops in this list.

EXPLANATION OF THE LISTS

List 1, column 1 - Name. The O.S. name and spelling is always followed, even when doubtful, as the list will generally be used in conjunction with the O.S. maps. The names given in C. W. Wall's "Mountaineering in Ireland", where they differ from those adopted in the list, are mentioned in the notes, as this is the standard book on the Irish mountains. It is only fair to Mr. Wall to explain that in practically every case where our nomenclature differs, it is because he has attached a name from a nearby lake or other feature to a mountain, purely in order to identify it. Names from the 6" map followed by FL

in the notes, are the name of the townland in which the summit lies. Names on the left margin are separate mountains; those inset are subsidiary tops of the mountain immediately above them in the list. Names of ranges have been inserted wherever they exist.

List 1, column 2 - Height. All heights are from the $\frac{1}{2}$ " map unless otherwise indicated. Heights followed by "c" are contour heights; those followed by "sl" are spot levels from the 5" map, and are not necessarily the highest point. There are also two or three approximate heights, which are distinguished in the notes. It should be noted that many triangulate heights are not actually on the summit - as Clashmore in the Sheefrys, or Teerwoyle Mountain on the Iberagh peninsula.

column 4 - $\frac{1}{2}$ " Sheet No. Though in no case is more than one sheet mentioned, some mountains occur on two overlapping sheets.

column 5 - Position. Bearings and distances are approximate, and distances are measured in a straight line.

List 2, column 4 - Section. It should be noted that the section numbers, which in List 1, are in Roman numerals, are here in Arabic for convenience of typing.

This is a secondary list; all information is derived from List 1, and there are, therefore, no sources or notes.
